

GULF AIR SIGNS NEW TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENT WITH SABRE

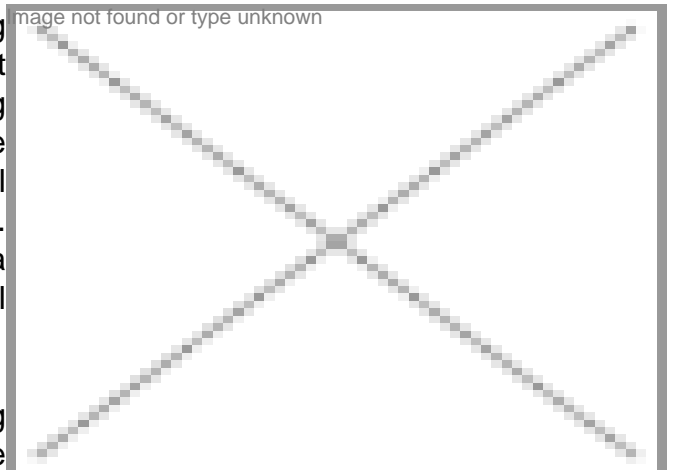
