

# TIGERAIR AUSTRALIA CELEBRATES 20 MILLIONTH PASSENGER

**Tigerair Australia is celebrating carrying its 20 millionth passenger since the now Virgin Australia-owned low-cost carrier began flying in 2007.**

**Passenger Sarah Del Medicio from Adelaide was presented with a \$2,000 voucher for travel on the Tigerair network as the milestone passenger, when she flew aboard flight TT449 from Melbourne to Adelaide on Monday morning.**

To celebrate the milestone, all 180 passengers on the flight were presented with a \$20 voucher, while Tigerair has launched a '20,000 one way fares for \$20' sale for flights on its domestic network between late January and late March 2017.

"The 20 millionth passenger milestone is a significant achievement for Tigerair Australia which commenced operations in Australia in November 2007," said Tigerair Australia CEO Rob Sharp, who was onboard the Melbourne-Adelaide flight.

"Tigerair Australia continues to go from strength to strength," he said.
