Latvian airline *airBaltic* will launch a new direct service from Riga to Lviv, Ukraine, on April 1, 2019. The new summer seasonal flights will offer convenient connections between the two cities. It will be already the third *airBaltic* destination in Ukraine in addition to Kiev and Odessa.
