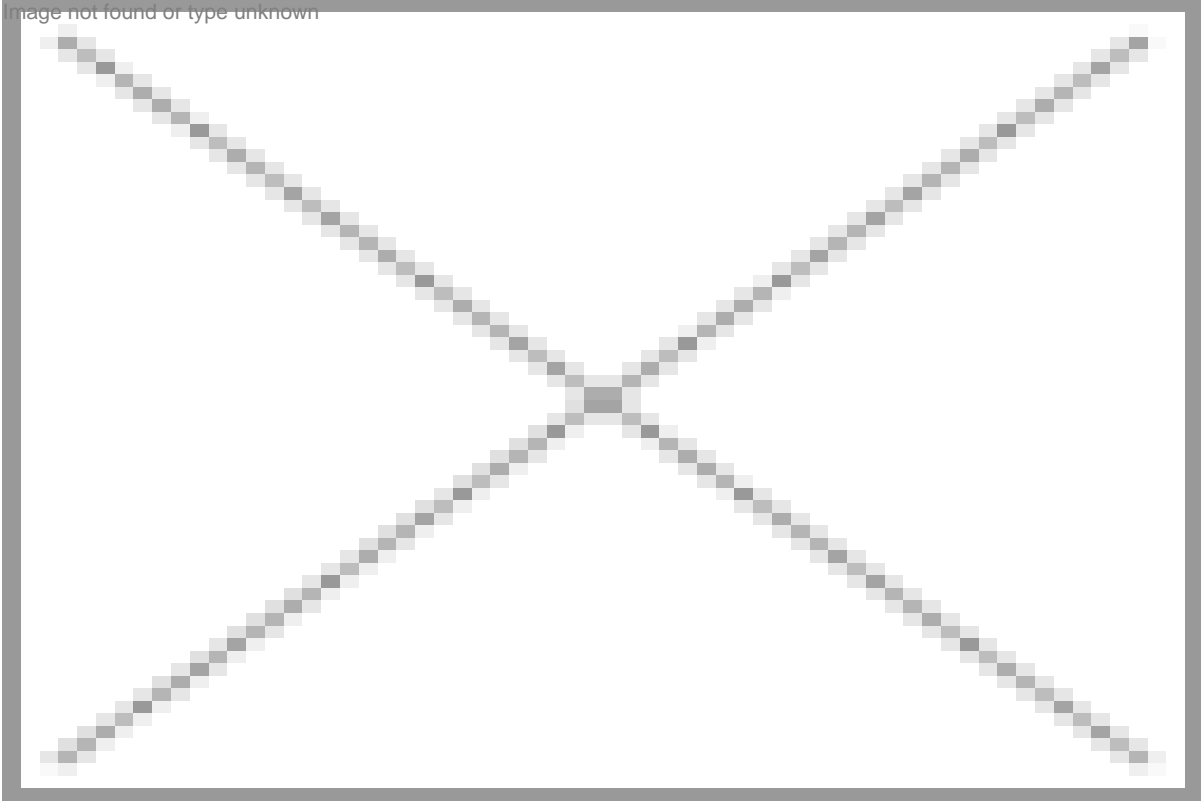
**British Airways, operated by Comair, is preparing to be the first airline to fly scheduled flights to St Helena.**

**Flights will depart Johannesburg's O.R. Tambo International Airport to St Helena and return each Saturday.**
