



# NEW CARGO OPPORTUNITIES BETWEEN TOKYO AND WARSAW

**Tokyo** is a new destination that has just appeared on the map of LOT's connections. It is of great importance, not only due to its potential to generate passenger traffic. For The Polish carrier's Dreamliners that will serve the Warsaw-Tokyo route three times a week, starting from January of next year, offer as much as 65 cubic meters of cargo space under their decks and are capable of carrying up to 15 tons of payload. The General Sales Agreement has been concluded today at the Polish airline's headquarters in Warsaw. Pursuant thereto, JAL Cargo will represent LOT in Japan, offering the cargo space available on LOT's Dreamliners. JAL Cargo will also handle the cargo carried on LOT's planes once these reach Tokyo's Narita airport. LOT Cargo and JAL Cargo will be also offering cargo space on other routes they serve.
