Ryanair, Europe's favourite low fares airline, today (20 April) announced its first Serbia flights, with a new route from Nis to Berlin commencing on 4 September, with a twice weekly service which will deliver 30,000 customers p.a. at Nis Airport.

- 1 new route to Berlin (2 x weekly – Thursday & Sunday)
- 2 weekly return flights to/from Nis Airport
- 30,000 customers p.a.

Ryanair celebrated announcing its new Nis to Berlin route by releasing seats for sale at prices starting from €24.99 for travel in September to November. These low fare seats are available for booking on the Ryanair.com website until midnight Wednesday (27 April).
