Passenger room controls include 787 incremental window shade grouping, multiple sources chosen from USB devices for overhead monitors or individual seat viewing and light controls. Cabin crews are able to view status of cabin services such as water levels for shower use, WAP

status for crew tablet and printer use and passenger telephone systems. Maintenance personal view system readiness and identify system anomalies pinpointing system remedies for full service.
