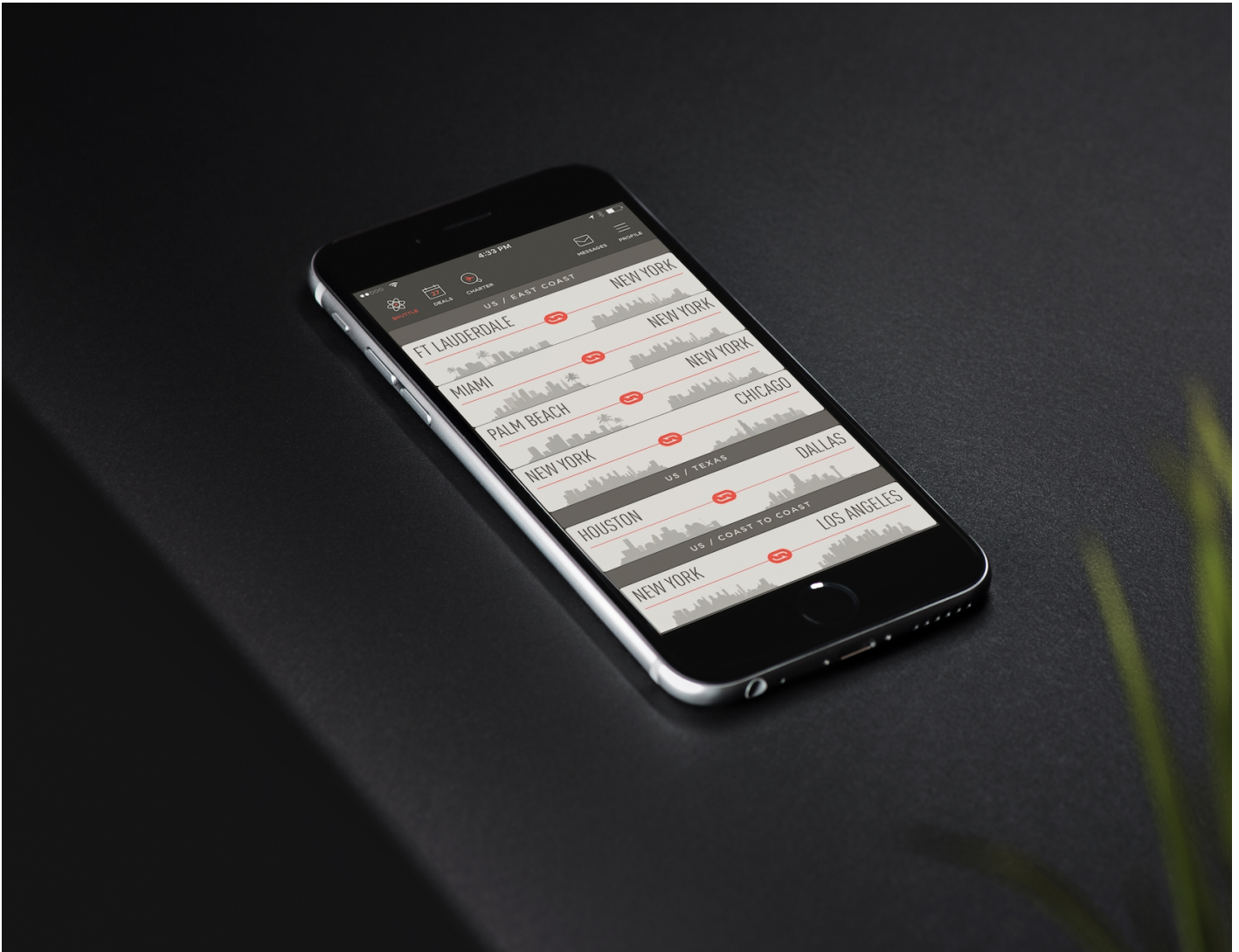


JETSMARTER ANNOUNCES MAJOR EUROPEAN EXPANSION

JetSmarter allows users to charter their own tailor-made flights at the touch of a button from their smartphone. Members (around £6,600 per year/\$9,675 USD) are able to fly on empty seats on existing luxury routes at no cost. With red-carpet boarding, catering and concierge services, JetSmarter makes flying private more accessible, more convenient, and more fun. Currently, JetSmarter's European routes include London – Nice, London – Paris, London – Geneva, Paris – Nice, and Nice- Moscow.

JetSmarter founder and CEO Sergey Petrossov commented: "We are very excited to continue the expansion of our JetShuttle service across Europe, offering an increasingly extensive and exciting schedule for our customers here. JetSmarter users enjoy a unique combination of luxurious transportation, excellent service and the chance to be completely spontaneous with their travel plans. We expect to operate JetShuttle routes across more cities worldwide in the next two years, bringing greater opportunities to explore the world in style."
